# Spa Set

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Mitts Width: 5½" Mitts Length: 11" Soap Sachet Width: 5½" Soap Sachet Length: 8¾"

### **MATERIALS**

**Universal Yarn** *Cotton Supreme Splash* (100% cotton; 100g/180 yds)

• 201 Beach – 2 hanks **Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) *or size* 

needed to obtain gauge

**Needle:** US Size 6 (4 mm) straight *or* size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

### **GAUGE**

20 sts x 7 rows = 4" in Granny Stitch pattern

Save time, check your gauge.

### **PATTERN NOTES**

The Soap Sachet is worked in 2 pieces and joined together with single crochet.

The bath mitts are worked flat in 1 piece. Stitches are picked up off the bottom edge of the mitts and ribbing is knit downward. The side and top seams are joined with single crochet.

### **STITCH GUIDE**

### **Granny Stitch**

(multiple of 5 sts + 3; add 2 for foundation ch)

**Set-up row:** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next ch, [ch 2, sk next 2 chs, dc in next 3 chs] across, turn.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] across to last 3 dc, end ch 2, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] across, end ch 2, 2 dc in last ch-2 sp, dc in last dc, turn.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.



### **SOAP SATCHET**

Side (make 2)

Ch 26. Work Set-up row of Granny Stitch patt. Rep Rows 1-2 of patt, 5 times, then rep Row 1, 1 more time. Do not fasten off at the end of the last Side.

### **Join Sides**

With WS together, join Sides with sl st down one long end, along begch edge, and along other long end, leaving final row open. Do not break yarn.

### **Top Edging**

Rnd 1: SI st to next ch-2 sp, ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3), dc in same sp, {ch 2, [dc, ch 2, dc] in next ch-2 sp} around, join with sI st in beg ch-6.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), work [3 dc, ch 3, sc] in same sp, [4 dc, ch 3, sc] in

each sp around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

### **FINISHING**

Place Sides WS together. Work sc evenly around 1 long side, bottom, and then other long side.

# Drawstring Clover End 1

Ch 4, join with sl st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work [sc, 3 dc, sc] 2 times in ring, [3 dc, sc] in ring, join with sl st to beg sc.

Without cutting yarn, make a crochet chain 16" long.

### **Clover End 2**

Ch 4 more, join with sl st to 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work [sc, 3 dc, sc] 2 times in ring, [3 dc, sc] in ring, join with sl st to beg sc.

### UNIVERSAL YARN

Fasten off. Weave Drawstring in and out of spaces from Rnd 1 of Top Edging.

### **MITTS**

Ch 55. Work Set-up row of Granny Stitch patt. Rep Rows 1-2 of patt,3 times.

### **Thumb Opening**

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] 4 times, ch 2, sk next ch-2 sp, [3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2] to last dc, dc in last dc, turn – 45 sts rem. Work Row 2 of Granny Stitch patt, then rep Rows 1-2 of patt, 3 times, then work Row 1, 1 more time. Fasten off.

### **Thumb**

Attach yarn to center of Thumb Opening.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in skipped ch-2 sp from Row 1 of Thumb Opening, ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp as beg dcs, ch 2, join with sl st to beg dc – 5 3-dc groups, 5 ch-2 sps.

Rnd 2: SI st back to last ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] 4 times, ch 2, 2 dc in same sp as beg ch-3, join with sI st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 3: SI st to next ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] 4 times, ch 2, join with sI st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4: SI st back to last ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp] 4 times, ch 1, 2 dc in same sp as beg ch-3, join with sI st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3 – 5 3-dc groups, 5 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 5: SI st to next ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc in each ch-1 sp around, join with sI st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Fasten off. Sew top of Thumb closed.

### Cuff

With knitting needles, working along beg-ch edge, pick up and knit 1 st for each ch - 53 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K1, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (RS):** \* P2, k2; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 until Cuff meas 1¾". Bind off all sts in patt.

### **FINISHING**

Fold Mitt in half with WS tog. Join side and top seam with sc.
